WHAT WE DO

Finding Kids exists to address a critical gap by deploying boots-on-the-ground private investigators to locate missing and exploited children. Our Aftercare team walks alongside families with practical, emotional, and spiritual support as they begin to rebuild their lives.

We **recover** missing children through field-based investigations.

We **care** for families and youth through parent support and aftercare services.

We **target** those who exploit children, helping to accelerate arrests.

All services are provided at no cost to families, law enforcement, or child welfare agencies.



We invite you to join us in our mission to bring light to places where darkness has taken hold. Below are simple, practical ways to engage your church. Our approach can be tailored to fit your ministry, schedule, and needs. For churches that feel called to engage more deeply, Finding Kids welcomes the opportunity to build meaningful, ongoing partnerships in this work.

SUNDAY SPOTLIGHT & LOBBY TABLE

A brief 5-minute introduction during announcements, followed by a staffed informational table.

LUNCH & LEARN

A 60-minute session after service on how children go missing locally – and how recovery and aftercare transform families.

AWARENESS MOVIE NIGHT

An evening film on child safety and restoration, followed by discussion and Q&A.

ANTI-TRAFFICKING EDUCATION WORKSHOP

A two-hour training for parents, ministry leaders, and youth workers on warning signs, digital risks, and practical response tools.

A CALL TO THE CHURCH

Young people are lured from the privacy of their bedrooms into online spaces – social media, gaming, and messaging – where predators groom them by building trust over time.

The moment a child disconnects from family and community, risk escalates. With every hour, the likelihood of exploitation and lasting trauma increases.

Meanwhile, law enforcement faces severe staffing shortages, heavy caseloads, and competing priorities, often leaving families to navigate crises with limited support.

We are called to defend the vulnerable, care for the broken, and act when others cannot. This work is not meant for one organization alone. It calls for the Church to step forward, raise awareness, support families, and pray earnestly.
